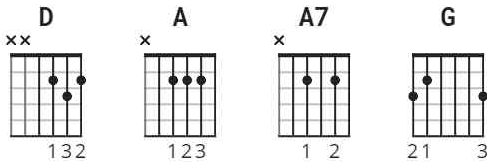


Seven Spanish Angels chords by Willie Nelson

Some people say this sounds better with a capo on the 3rd fret, personally I play it without a capo, but try lots of different things and see what works for you.
